

COVID-19 INFORMATION UPDATE:

PROVINCE OF ONTARIO NON-ESSENTIAL BUSINESS CLOSURE – Exemption for Quad Engineering QUAD ENGINEERING INC – Coronavirus update 24 Mar 2020

The province of Ontario issued guidelines on 23 March 2020 for companies in essential industries and services to keep operating during the Coronavirus state of emergency.

Under the Ontario mandate, QUAD Engineering is considered an essential business and will remain open. QUAD will continue to operate to serve our customers as a supplier of engineering and equipment to the steel and other primary metals industries (paragraph 19 of Manufacturing and Production exemptions list).

For the safety of our employees, suppliers and customers, many of our employees will be working from home. Visits to the office will be occasional and on an 'as required' basis only. Anyone visiting the office will be required to practice social distancing and other hygiene protection as now well publicized by Health Canada.
